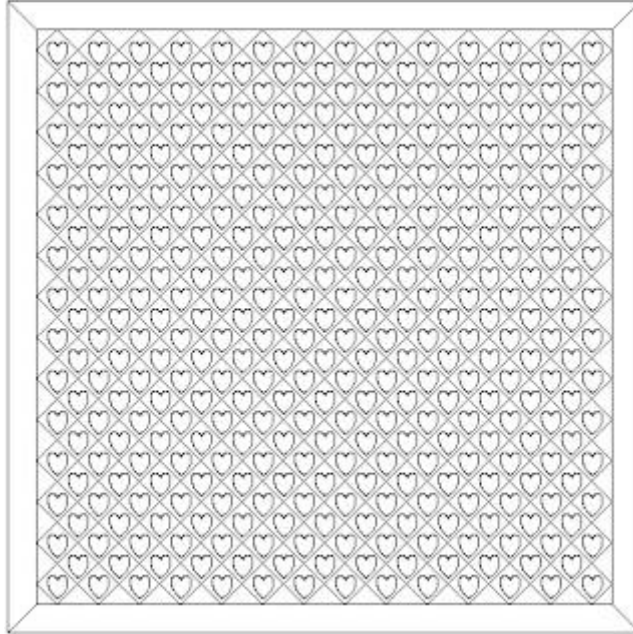




Appliqué a heart every day...at the end of the year you have a special quilt...

365 little hearts...every day a bit of love



196 x 196 cm  
365 hearts together  
14 on a row  
14 rows high

### Materials

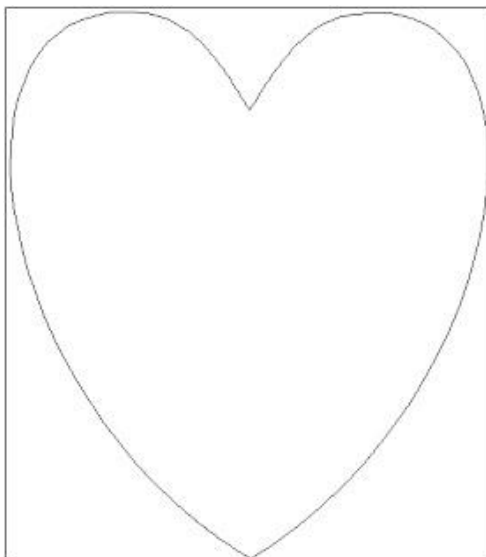
*fabrics are 110 cm wide*

- 4 m of fabric for the background squares
- 0,6 m of fabric for the triangles
- a lot of scraps for the hearts
- 1 meter of fabric for the border
- 0,5 m of fabric for the binding
- 4,2 m of fabric for the backing
- 210 x 210 cm of batting

### Step-by-step

*including 0,5 cm seam allowances*

- cut 365 squares 10 x 10 cm of the background fabric
- cut 13 squares 15,25 x 15,25 cm of the triangle fabric. Cut each square two times diagonally to get 52 triangles
- cut 2 squares 8,25 x 8,25 cm of the triangle fabric. Cut each square once diagonally to get 4 triangles



Template of the little heart

The size of the rectangle is 6,3 cm x 7,25 cm

If you print this page you have to check this size ...The template is without seam allowances

Use your template to draw your hearts and use your favorite method to appliqué.

Start in the upper left corner and make diagonal rows. There are 14 hearts on a horizontal row with a total of 14 rows (and 13 rows of 13 hearts between them)

Have a lot of fun.

If you like to work with inches? All the measurements are on a separate pdf.
